Road traffic noise remains the major noise problem affecting Hong Kong. Road traffic noise measurement is an important subject as it provides a clear picture of noise climate of our environment. To bring the most update techniques and also to meet the need of continuous professional development and training, HKIOA is now organizing a workshop specifically on road traffic noise measurement. The workshop aims at providing the local industry with updated skills and techniques required for road traffic noise measurement. Apart from theoretical sessions, a practical session will be conducted for on-site noise measurement:

Day 1: Basic acoustics and instrumentation

Day 2: Hands-on experience on road traffic noise measurement and latest developments in instrumentation

Day 3: Practical session: On-site road traffic noise measurement

Day 4: Road traffic noise related legislation, policy and practices & end-of-course assessment
