(Hearing Conservation Best Practices Award Scheme 2006)


The project won the **Excellence Award** in the Hearing Conservation Best Practices Award Scheme 2006 jointly organized by Occupational Safety & Health Council, Labour Department, Occupational Deafness Compensation Board and Pneumoconiosis Compensation Fund Board. China Overseas Building Construction Limited is the main contractor.

Description

The project management is committed to establishing and implementing innovative measures to reduce occupational noise exposure to construction workers as well as nuisance to the public. To promote experience sharing with other industry players, the project participated in the Hearing Conservation Best Practices Award Scheme 2006 and successfully won the Excellence Award.

The technical visit includes slide presentation and site walk. Administrative occupational noise control measures; details of a movable, modular noise barrier which is constructed on water filled road barriers as well as other interesting site arrangements will be introduced to the visitors.
