Talk on "AIIB Definition of Intelligent Building and the Assessment of Noise and Vibration"

Venue: Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club

Honorable Speaker, Professor Andrew Y.T. LEUNG of the City University of Hong Kong:

Professor Andrew Y.T. Leung obtained his Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering, Aston University, U.K. He has been lecturing as Chair professor at the City University of Hong Kong since 1999. He was the Head of the Department of Building and Construction, 1999 – 2005, and President of the Hong Kong Institute of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics, 2002-2004. Currently, he is the President of the Asian Institute of Intelligent Buildings, and President of the Hong Kong Association for Computational Mechanics. Professor Leung is a registered professional engineer in both Hong Kong and United Kingdom, and a chartered surveyor in United Kingdom. He has participated in various government and public building and civil engineering projects. Professor Leung is also the editor-in-chief of an International Journal, and editorial board members of several International Journals. He published over two hundred publications in international refereed journal papers, international conference papers, and research and consultancy reports.

Outline of the Talk:

AIIB established in 2000, is the first non-profit making organization in Asia that comprises individuals and companies in the region committed to promoting public understanding and industry adoption of the principles and technologies of the intelligent building (IB). AIIB adopted the definition of IB as "An Intelligent Building is designed and constructed based on an appropriate selection of Quality Environment Modules to meet the User's Requirements by mapping with the appropriate building facilities to achieve a Long-Term Building Value ". In this talk, the development of building intelligence, various building models, and the intelligent building index adopted in AIIB are described in detail. Some examples showing the effects of noise and vibration on an intelligent building are also illustrated.
