



SOUNDSCAPE CERTIFICATE COURSE

Soundscape has recently been defined by International Organization of Standardization as “[the] acoustic environment as perceived or experienced and/or understood by a person or people, in context” (ISO 2014). In the same way as landscape is what we see and its meaning to us, soundscape is all what we hear and how it affects us. In the last ten years, there has been a growing interest in soundscape studies and an increasing number of publications in scientific literature of the field. There is increasing evidence that the soundscape we live in can affect our health and well-being. It is also contended that the soundscape approach can augment our conventional noise control approach in managing the urban acoustic environment. This course gives an introduction to soundscape, what we measure and evaluate and how we can craft a soundscape that promotes health.

He was bestowed the honour of Silver Bauhinia Star by the Hong Kong SAR Government for his community work in protecting the environment of Hong Kong.
